Wildfire and Disaster Resources for Providers

Wildfires Can Disrupt Vision Practices and Patient Care. We are here to support you with essential resources to help you navigate these challenges.

After the Governor declared a state of emergency due to the wildfires, Vision Plan of America is taking steps to help mitigate the impact to enrollees and providers.

For Providers in California who were displaced by the fires the following will apply:

1. Extension of the duration of existing prior authorizations by 180 calendar days so providers can focus on providing care to enrollees rather than having to re-request prior authorization for previously authorized services.

2. For a period of at least 6 months from March 19, 2025, displaced providers will be allowed to deliver care from appropriate alternative settings, such as mobile clinics or temporary locations.
